Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 for registration of FIR against respondents No.4 and 5 under Sections 354-D, 498-A, 406, 107, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000.

Counsel representing respondent No.4 submits that dispute between the parties was on account of marital discord, which has been settled by virtue of compromise dated 22.03.2022. He submits that marriage between the parties has been dissolved by judgment and decree dated 01.04.2022 under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. According to

counsel, since dispute has been resolved, instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case anything still survives.
