Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.118 dated 15.09.2021 registered under Sections 306, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was married to victim, namely, Prem Singh in the year 2008 and on 12.09.2021, he gave beating to her and she was admitted in hospital. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner intimated about this occurrence to her parents, whereupon they allegedly scolded him and gave beatings. According to learned counsel, Prem Singh ended his life on 14.09.2021. He further submits that the differences between husband and wife cannot be construed as an abetment to suicide, at least against the petitioner who suffered serious injuries on 12.09.2021.

Notice of motion for 25.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner

shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Manjeet Singh, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2021 is made absolute.
