This petition was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 386, dated 9th September, 2019, under Sections 307 and 384 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Udyog Vihar, Police Station, Gurugram, District Gurugram and all other proceedings on the basis of compromise.

The quashing is sought on the basis of compromise. Section 307 IPC is involved in the FIR.

Inspite of two pass overs, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender on 4th June, 2022 and the petition is not maintainable in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in State of **Madhya Pradesh v. Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019(2) RCR (Criminal) 225.**

In view of the facts that the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and petition had been filed without annexing the challan.

The petition is dismissed.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for recalling of the order in case any factual discrepancy found.
