Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been given any transfer whereas one Spatter Singh has been posted at the place of the present posting of the petitioner by the impugned transfer effected vide order dated 28.08.2022, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that despite the fact that the petitioner mentioned nine options for transfer but the same has not been found favour with the respondents and that too without any valid justification, rather petitioner has not been given any place of posting as of now.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana,

who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that he has instructions to submit before this Court that non-grant of transfer to the petitioner is the result of the fact that the petitioner mentioned himself as TGT Teacher rather than C&V Teacher, due to which petitioner could not be given any place of posting.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that now the grievance of the petitioner will be redressed in the grievance drive which will be undertaken by the respondent-Department and the petitioner be directed to participate in the said drive so as to redress his grievance and to allot him a suitable place of posting.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that he has instructions to submit before this Court that till the petitioner participates in the grievance drive as and when initiated and is allotted a place of posting, the petitioner will not be relieved from the present place of posting.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that statement of the State counsel redresses the grievance of the petitioner as of now and the petitioner undertakes to participate in the grievance drive as and when initiated by the respondents so as to allot a place of posting to the petitioner and prays that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
