[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 22.04.2022 in CWP-8169-2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.8169 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 07.01.2022 as well as by taking into account the contentions raised in the writ petition and take a decision in respect thereto in accordance with law within two months from 22.04.2022.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 08.09.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner for being allowed extension in service beyond 58 years. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the

petitioner to challenge order dated 08.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
