The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondent No.2 and 3 to remove the encroachers from land measuring 3 Kanals approximately. In the written statement, it has been pointed out that there were 13 encroachers in total. Pursuance to the eviction orders passed by the Competent Authority, the possession from 10 encroachers has already been taken back, whereas, qua the remaining 3 encroachers, the proceedings under the Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction & Rent Recovery) Act, 1973, are pending.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of while requesting the Authority hearing the proceedings under the Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction & Rent Recovery) Act, 1973, to dispose of the petition positively within a period of three months, from today.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
