Main case

The instant petition is for quashing of impugned order dated 08.07.2022 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar (Annexure-P-3) whereby, the non-bailable warrants of the petitioner were issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that after being granted the concession of bail, petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court. Only on 08.07.2022 the petitioner could not appear as he had noted a wrong date.

A perusal of the order dated 08.07.2022 (Annexure P-3), shows neither the petitioner appeared before the trial Court nor any exemption application had been moved on his behalf.

However, there seems no justification to interfere with the order dated 08.07.2022 (Annexure P-3), but in the interest of justice, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 16.09.2022 and to apply for regular bail.

In case, such an application for bail is moved by the petitioner before the trial Court, the same shall be considered and decided on the same date in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
