1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.03.2022 in CRM-M-8748-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M-8748-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 15.02.2022, by passing a speaking order within 30 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of Annexure R/1 i.e. statement of the petitioner to the police authorities that he does not want any action on the complaint filed by him, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
