The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 11.08.2022, registered under Sections 365, 384, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bhadour, District Barnala.

Notice of motion was issued on 31.08.2020, pursuant to which respondents Nos.2 to 4 had put in appearance, respondent No.2-complainant, respondent No.3- son of the complainant and respondent

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No.4- brother of the complainant and had sought time to file reply. According to the affidavit dated 16.09.2020 which has been placed on record, respondent Nos.2 to 4 who are signatories of the same have submitted that they have entered into a compromise dated 20.08.2022 with the petitioner, which has been appended as Annexure P-3 along with the petition and do not wish to proceed with the FIR No.48 dated 11.08.2022, registered under Sections 365, 384, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bhadour, District Barnala.

In view of above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within 15 days from today. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and the petitioner is directed to adhere to the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
