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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner praying for quashing of tender proceedings in which the respondent-authorities proposes to allot the work in question to respondent No.4. He, however, fairly concedes that he has filed a complaint against the findings given by respondent-authorities which is pending adjudication before the authorities. He, therefore, submits that respondent-authorities be directed to consider his complaint and take a decision thereon.

Learned Senior Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent-Union Territory, Chandigarh submits that if the aforesaid complaint of the petitioner is pending before the respondent-authorities, the same would be considered and a decision thereon would be taken within a week and if it has already been decided, the decision would be communicated to the petitioner.
