[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel states that in view of order Annexure P-3 dated 08.08.2021 passed in compliance of order Annexure P-1 dated 22.09.2020 in CWP No.15042 of 2020, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure P-3 dated 08.08.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law

[3] Notice has not been issued in the instant petition.

[4] In view of order Annexure P-3 dated 08.08.2021 having been passed by the respondents in terms of order Annexure P/1 dated 22.09.2020 in CWP No.15042 of 2020 though beyond the stipulated period of time of two months as well as statement of learned counsel for

the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents.

[5] Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure P-3 dated 08.08.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
