The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to take action on the representation dated 26.08.2022 made by the petitioners for protecting their life and liberty from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Mr. Harpal Singh Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.5 and filed his power of attorney in the Court which is taken on record.

Status report by way of an affidavit dated 12.10.2022 of Sh. Satvir Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police (SD), Barnala, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record. As per the status report, the enquiry was conducted by SHO, Police Station Dhanaula and during enquiry private

respondents No.4 and 5 produced their affidavits in which they have clearly mentioned that they have no objection upon the relationship of the petitioners. Apart from this police tried its level best to approach the petitioners but it was found that the petitioners are not residing at the address given by them. There is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the above report, no further direction is required to be given in the present petition which is disposed of accordingly.
