The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory in case FIR No.191, Dated 21.07.2022, under Sections 306, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 6, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that there is a delay of more than 1 year and 10 months in lodging the present FIR as the alleged incident took place on 03.10.2020. He further contended that the FIR against the petitioner is nothing but total abuse of process of law. His assertion is that the complainant's brother was under debt of the market, due to which, he committed suicide on dated 03.10.2020.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that there is a serious allegation against the petitioner and the name of the petitioner is available in the suicide note.

In view of afore-said facts and circumstances and keeping in

view the gravity of offence, petitioner does not deserve the concession of

pre-arrest bail.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
