The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the petitioner against the personal bond.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner was arrested on 11.01.2021 and was thereafter granted the default bail. Onerous conditions for furnishing bail bonds had been imposed against the petitioner.

It is not disputed that the aforesaid conditions of bail were subject matter of challenge before this Court in CRM-M-16487-2021 and that said conditions already stand affirmed vide order dated 28.05.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner thus seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
