HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner being physically handicapped, is entitled for certain marks for the said disability, which benefit is not being given to the petitioner while computing marks for effecting transfers. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance with the respondents by serving a legal notice dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-5) but the apprehension of the petitioner is that without addressing the grievance of the petitioner, the petitioner will be transferred.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as the transfers are yet to be effected, the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Saini, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-5) within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
