AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition seeking quashing of order dated 8.1.2016 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nabha declaring the petitioner as Proclaimed Offender in Criminal Complaint No. COMA/887/2015 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, titled as “Rajinder Singh v. Pardeep Kumar and another”.

After arguing for some time and realising that the contentions are not finding favour, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within fifteen days from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Without commenting on the contention raised with regard to compromise, the petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within fifteen from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail

application within three days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
