The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of impugned order dated 15.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri in Criminal Appeal titled as “Maya Ram Vs. Dhru Sharma” bearing No.CRA-99-2022 only to the extent whereby the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri directed the petitioner to deposit 20% amount of the compensation awarded by the Trial Court in Criminal Complaint No.947 of 2016 titled as Dhru Sharma Versus Maya Ram.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he shall satisfy if a direction is issued to the Lower Appellate Court to conclude the hearing of the appeal within a reasonable time.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the present case as also the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri to conclude the hearing of the appeal as expeditiously as possible not later than three months from the next date fixed before it.
