The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.41 dated 12.05.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, 307 IPC at Police Station Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 13.12.2022 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala and the same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Sukhchain Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 30.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
