This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 180 dated 17.9.2021, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Nihalsinghwala District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length and realizing that the contentions are not finding favour, in order to avoid adverse order, on instructions from his client submits that the petitioner restrict his prayer that petitioner would surrender within fifteen days and apply for regular bail, his bail application be decided expeditiously.

The prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

The petition is disposed of. In case the petitioner surrenders within fifteen days and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
