The present petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer to the respondents to release the amount of gratuity as well as ACP along with interest.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that all the benefits for which the petitioner is found entitled for, have already been paid and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has no instructions with regard to the payment of the benefits to the petitioner but as the learned counsel for the respondents has made a statement at the bar, the said statement is not being disputed by the petitioner but the petitioner

be given liberty to approach in case, any of his grievance still survives.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner raising any grievance, the same will be looked into in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
