Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the petition at this stage. However, he has prayed that a direction be issued to the trial Court to complete the trial in an expeditious manner.

In view of the status report received from the trial Court, the trial is moving at a satisfactory pace. Nevertheless, while allowing the request of counsel for the petitioner seeking withdrawal of the present petition, the trial Court is directed to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously by giving short adjournments, refusing to grant adjournment except for justifiable reasons, which are to be recorded in the order. The State shall cause appearance of the remaining prosecution

witnesses on each date so fixed. Of course, no unnecessary adjournment would be asked on behalf of the accused, if trial is to proceed expeditiously. The necessary exercise be completed preferably within a period of 06 months from the date of receipt of copy of order there.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
