MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.214 dated 04.08.2021 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 506, 325, 120-B and 326 read with Section 34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Submits, inter alia, that the petitioner's name does not transpire in the FIR and his complicity has been revealed only from the disclosure statement of the co-accused Gurpreet Singh.

2.Notice of motion.

3.Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG, Haryana to accept notice on behalf of the State. Let a copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

4.To come up on 16.12.2021.

5.Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

*I That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;
II That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
III That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Wazir Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2021 is made absolute.
