The petitioner pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 113 dated 01.07.2021, registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 of the IPC (Sections 326, 201 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 14.10.2021, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel contends that the parties are closely related and have arrived at a settlement. He submits that a separate petition bearing No.CRM-M-43756-2021 has been filed for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion for 11.02.2022.

At this stage, Mr. Lalit Goyal, Advocate has appeared on behalf of complainant/respondent No.2.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 14.10.2021, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners has joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 14.10.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
