Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.193, dated 17.08.2021, under Sections 465, 468, 471, 474, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kharar, District Mohali, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the alleged No Objection Certificate was issued by the builder in favour of the purchaser of the flat in question and petitioner being property dealer has been falsely implicated in this case. He has further submitted that the employee of the company, namely, Amritpal Singh, who actually issued no objection certificate has already been released on anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion for 08.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Jaswant Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2021 is made absolute.
