Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not all but most of the benefits for which the petitioner had approached this Court have been released by the respondents and the only grievance survives in the present petition is for the grant of interest on the delayed release of the pensionary benefits as well as the release of the withheld pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to approach the respondents seeking the release of the pensionary benefit which are yet to be released along with the grant of interest, by submitting a representation.

Learned State counsel submits that if any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming any benefit, it will be considered and decided in accordance with the rule governing the service coupled with the settled principle of law within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same by passing appropriate order and in case the petitioner is found entitled for any relief the same will also be extended to him within a period of next four
