Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned result of written examination for the post of Supervisor (Female) of Women and Child Development, Haryana, held as per Advertisement No.07/2016 (Category No.17).

2. Pursuant to the advertisement *ibid*, petitioner applied under ESM General category. On the basis of self-assessment, she claims to have secured 98 marks but yet her name did not figure in the list of candidates called for scrutiny of documents, contends the counsel.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In the return filed to the writ petition, respondents have taken a specific stand in Para-4 thereof that the petitioner was not shortlisted and

called for scrutiny of documents due to less marks than the last selected candidate in the DESM-General Category. The last shortlisted candidate who was called for interview in DESM-General category has secured 136 marks while the petitioner secured much lesser marks.

6. In the premise, it seems that being unaware of her actual result, the petitioner was misled into filing the instant petition. Whereas, she has actually scored lesser marks than the last selected candidate of her category, as aforesaid.

7. The result of the petitioner is not under challenge before this Court. Being so, no further grounds to interfere are made out.

8. Dismissed.
