Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner who was working as Extension Lecturer in the subject of Zoology, is entitled for re-adjustment keeping in view the policy dated 04.03.2020 as amended on 11.05.2022 but claim of the petitioner is not being considered by the respondents in a correct perspective and the order passed by the respondents declining the same benefit to the petitioner on 25.11.2021 is contrary to not only the policy dated 04.03.2020 but now in view of the clarification dated 11.05.2022, petitioner is fully eligible to re-adjustment as Extension Lecturer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the clarification dated 11.05.2022, the petitioner is fully eligible, hence, the respondents are liable to reconsider their decision dated 25.11.2021

(Annexure P-19). Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 11.07.2022 with the respondents raising the said claim, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-31 with this petition, hence, the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner afresh keeping in view the amendment to the policy dated 04.03.2020 vide notification dated 11.05.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that application of the petitioner dated 11.07.2022 (Annexure P-31) will be considered by the appropriate authority and the same will be decided within a period eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order, if not already decided.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 11.07.2022 (Annexure P-31), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 11.07.2022 (Annexure P-31) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
