SANT PARKASH, J.

On 24.11.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

Status report dated 08.11.2021 by way of affidavit of Sanjeev Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Licensing and Security, Amritsar City, already filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for petitioner inter alia contends that version, as alleged in the FIR, is totally concocted one and there is no iota of truth therein. He further submits that allegedly petitioner inflicted knife blow on the right leg of complainant- Gurvinder Singh @ Ginny and the said injury has been declared simple in nature. He further submits that though petitioner has no nexus whatsoever with the alleged offence, he is ready to join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency.

Adjourned to 12.01.2022.

Meanwhile, in the eventuality of arrest of petitioner in the instant case FIR, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the

satisfaction of Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall join investigation on 29.11.2021 at 10:00 AM sharp before the Investigating Officer at Police Station Islamabad, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and on any other subsequent date as informed to him by the Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall abide by conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbinder Singh, submits that in compliance of the above-said order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

Taking into consideration the totality of circumstances, the interim order dated 24.11.2021 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
