Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to be issued to the learned Special Judge, District Patiala adjudicating the case FIR No.142 dated 27.11.2016, registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala, under Sections 307, 392, 223, 224, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 201, 419, 170, 171, 353, 186, 212, 216 and 489 IPC; Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959; Sections 11, 13, 16, 17, 18, 20 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention Act) 1967; and Sections 22 & 29 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, have been added later on), to adjudicate the matter on a day to day basis in the spirit of Section 309 Cr.P.C. read with Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the trial is moving at a good pace as all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and now the case is fixed for recording the statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the zimini orders, as per which also, the trial is moving at a good pace and very short dates are being given.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, has submitted that he would not press the present petition, at this stage and prayed that the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same, as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of, as having not been pressed.

The trial Court has been making a good progress in the present case and it is expected that the trial Court would proceed and try to conclude the trial, as expeditiously as possible.
