This is a first petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents no.2 and 3 for submitting report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR no.0059 dated 24.04.2020 registered under Sections 379, 411, 473 IPC at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Gurnam Singh, has submitted that in the present case, three persons have been arrested and the car in question and an FD of Rs.2 lacs have been recovered and every effort is being made to submit the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. expeditiously and the same, in all likelihood would be submitted within a period of three weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and has prayed that a direction be issued that the said report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. be filed as expeditiously as possible

preferably within a period of three weeks from today.

Learned State counsel is directed to submit the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in the above said FIR as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three weeks from today.
