The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of the India for seeking the issuance of a Writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the Award (Annexure P-9) dated 13.03.2015 passed by the Victim Compensation Committee, Sangrur, vide which the claim of the petitioner for compensation and medical treatment has been rejected on the ground that the petitioner has already arrived at a compromise with the respondent No.3 regarding the incident, and he is, therefore, not entitled to any compensation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the requisite relief has already been granted to the petitioner during the pendency of the instant petition and hence, the present petition has become infructuous.
