ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.140 dated 07.06.2020 (*wrongly mentioned as 07.06.2021*) under Sections
302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was
passed by this Court on 14.10.2021: -

*“...Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the
police had in fact not nominated the petitioner as an accused in
the report submitted under Section 173 Cr.P.C., even on the basis*

of CCTV footage of the hospital where the petitioners' mother was admitted, i.e. Ved Parkash Hospital, Rewari, which he submits is about 30 kms from the place of occurrence as recorded in the FIR; and therefore, at time of occurrence the petitioner was seen in the hospital at about 4:00 pm.

Since the petitioner has been summoned by the trial court in an application filed under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C., the complainant in the FIR, i.e. Gaurav Kumar son of Surinder Singh, is ordered to be impleaded as respondent no.2 in the petition with the Registry directed to carry out necessary corrections, in the memo of parties, taking his particulars from the copy of the FIR (Annexure P-1). ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and he is released on interim bail and is facing the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 14.10.2021 passed by this Court, vide which interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
