The instant Civil Writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, Mandamus or direction to quash the impugned award dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-8) passed by the respondent No.1.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous since the respondent No.2 has already fulfill the conditions that are pre-requisite for release of the electricity connection and release of the connection has already been offered to the respondent No.2.

The aforesaid averment is not denied by the counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2. The offer for release of the connection has already been made and the respondent No.2 has fulfilled

his eligibility conditions for securing release of said electric connection.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 does not dispute the factum of offer of release of connection, however, he prays the petitioners be directed to release the electricity connection in time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of directing the petitioners to release the electricity connection within a period of 45 days of receipt of certified copy of this order subject to the respondent No.2 satisfying the conditions pre-requisite for release of the electricity connection.
