Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 02.10.2020, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Police Station Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 03.09.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 03.09.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that the parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable settlement but the same remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 however, submits that the articles are yet to be recovered.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 03.09.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
