LISA GILL, J.

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of orders dated 18.09.2018 (Annexures P-8 and P-9), 20.09.2018 (Annexures P-10 and P11) whereby petitioners have been transferred from ITI Sonipat to other Districts, claiming said orders to be illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 14 and 16 of The Constitution of India besides Transfer Policy dated 07.04.1989. This writ petition was listed for hearing yesterday i.e. 12.05.2022.

Learned counsel for the State had pointed out that this writ petition is rendered infructuous in view of order dated 21.02.2019 passed by Assistant Director (Admn-M), Director General, Skill Development and Industrial Training Department, Haryana, whereby impugned transfer orders have been withdrawn. Copy of order dated 21.02.2019 was furnished in Court yesterday. Matter was adjourned for today, at request of learned counsel for the petitioners to enable him to verify. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the specific averment on behalf of the respondents, I find no justification for continuation of the present proceedings. Photocopy of order dated 21.02.2019 is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is afforded to the petitioners to move appropriate application within four weeks, in case any incorrect fact has been projected before this Court.
