AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

Prayer in the present petition is that no proceeding has been undertaken by the local Police to arrest and nabbed the proclaimed offenders-respondent Nos.5 and 6 as no FIR under Section 174-A IPC has been registered against them.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 25.10.2021. Pursuant to which short reply dated 11.10.2022 by way of affidavit of Shubeg Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Fazilka filed.

Learned State counsel makes a reference to para 5 thereof which reads thus:-

“That it is further respectfully submitted that subsequently vide order dated 18.07.2019 Ld. Court of J.M.I.C. Fazilka had ordered to register FIR under section 174-A IPC only against respondent No.6. Accordingly, FIR No.24 dated 15.02.2022 was registered under section 174-A IPC against respondent No.6 Shamer Chand Jossan. Said accused/respondent No.6 was confined in Central Jail, Shri Muktsar Sahib

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in FIR No.119 dated 30.09.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at P.S. City, Jalalabad. Therefore, on 04.03.2022, after obtaining production warrant from the Ld. Court of C.J.M. Fazilka, respondent No.6 was arrested and joined in investigation of FIR No.24 dated 25.02.2022.”

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
