CM-9014-CWP-2022:

The present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 18.05.2022, passed by this Court in the main petition, being CWP-26477-2017, vide which order the main case was dismissed for non-prosecution.

In view of the averments made in the present application, the same is allowed and the order dated 18.05.2022, passed by this Court in the main petition, being CWP-26477-2017, is recalled. CWP-26477-2017 is restored to its original number and the same is taken up on the Board today itself for consideration.

CM-9015-CWP-2022:

The present application has been filed for impleading the legal

representatives of the deceased-petitioner in the memorandum of parties of CWP-26477-2017, so as to continue with the proceedings in the main petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly supported by the affidavit filed by Sukhchain Singh, i.e. legal representative of the deceased-petitioner, the same is allowed and the legal representatives of the deceased-petitioner are impleaded as parties in CWP-26477-2017.

Amended memorandum of parties is taken on record.

CWP-26477-2017:

In the present petition, prayer of the petitioner is that Late Sadhu Singh, who had worked with the respondent-Forest Department, is entitled for the grant of pensionary benefits under the old Pension Scheme, keeping in view the fact that Late Sadhu Singh was continuously working with the respondent-Department, starting from the year 1978 up to the date when he unfortunately died, i.e. 14.05.2010.

Learned State counsel very fairly submits that the respondent-Forest Department had prepared a list of the employees, whose cases are covered by the settled principle of law laid down by the Division Bench of this Court, while deciding **CWP-2371-2010** titled as ***“Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others”***, decided on 31.08.2010, in which list, name of Late Sadhu Singh is also mentioned and his case is under consideration by the authorities concerned for the grant of necessary relief under the old pension scheme and the said relief will be released in favour of the legal representatives of the deceased-petitioner within a period of two months of completing all the necessary formalities by them.

the statement made by learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage.
