Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.168 dated 20.07.2022 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 02.09.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that the parties have duly appeared before the Mediation Centre and the matter has been amicably resolved.

Report of the Mediator dated 08.12.2022 has also been received affirming the fact that the matter has been amicably settled.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also affirmed the fact that the matter has been settled amicably.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 02.09.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
