The present petition has been filed for issuing directions to the respondents to hand over the investigation of FIR No.0187 dated 02.04.2022 registered under Sections 307 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Quilla Panipat, Haryana to the officers not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

Notice served upon the official respondents through State's counsel. No notices are required to issue to the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case direction be issued to respondent No.3, to decide the representation dated 11.08.2022 (Annexure P-2) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.3-Inspector General, Panipat, IG Karnal Police, Karan Vihar, Karnal, Haryana-132001, to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) either himself or by authorizing any officer of IPS cadre, by passing a speaking and reasoned order ***within 30 working days from today and communicate the order to the petitioner immediately.***

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.

The concerned authorities to communicate the order to the representationist without any delay.
