Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to move an application for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a lady aged about 54 years and is stated to be passing through difficult time inasmuch as all the male members of the family are stated to be in custody, which is stated to have resulted in loss to their occupation inasmuch as 18 of their buffaloes died, it is directed that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 2 days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of one week from filing of such application while duly taking into

account all the submissions as may be raised by the petitioner including her family circumstances.
