Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detainee namely Jasmeen daughter of the petitioner, who is stated to be in illegal confinement of respondent No.4.

On the last date of hearing 30.08.2022, following order was passed:-

“ Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detainee namely Jasmeen daughter of the petitioner, who is stated to be in illegal confinement of respondent No.4.

Registry is directed to appoint a Warrant Officer who shall visit the alleged places of detention and any other place as may be pointed out by the petitioner. In case the Warrant Officer finds that the above named detainee in the illegal detention of respondent No.4, he shall proceed to set her free forthwith and record her statement. Warrant Officer may take help from the concerned police station, if need so arises.

Report to this effect shall be prepared and submitted by the Warrant Officer on or before the next date of hearing. The

remuneration of the Warrant Officer shall be borne by the petitioner.

In pursuance of order dated 30.08.2022, report of the Warrant Officer has been received wherein, it is stated that the alleged detenue Jasmeen had married with Dilpreet Singh in the year 2020 at her own will and presently she on her family way having 5 months pregnancy. It is further stated in the report that her mother-in-law is not treating her well and therefore, she intends to go with her parents, however, she has no complaint with her husband. Statements of the alleged detenue and her parents are annexed with the report as Annexure R-2 and R-3.

It is further evident from the report of the Warrant Officer that entries were made in the Roz Namcha, vide General Diary No.042, dated 31.08.2022 and statement of Sh. Kirpal Singh, Station House Officer has also been recorded, which is annexed with the report as Annexure R-5.

In view of the report of the Warrant Officer, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing survives in the present petition, as his grievance stands redressed.

Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
