Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.201 dated 11.05.2022, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 377, 506 read with Section 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kunjpura, District Karnal along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail remedies as available to the petitioner under law. He has further submitted that the petitioners are the senior citizens and they may be granted personal exemption from their appearance before the trial Court.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, keeping in view that the petitioners are the senior citizens, they are deserving the grant of personal exemption before the trial Court. Accordingly, trial Court is directed to grant exemption to the petitioners from their personal appearance during trial subject to their filing affidavit to the following effect:-

1. That they will have no objection if the statements of witnesses are recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel.
2. That they will appear before the trial Court as & when required to do so by it.
3. That they will abide by any other condition imposed by the trial Court while granting them exemption from personal appearance.
