Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 0042 dated 17.05.2021, under Sections 307, 506 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act were deleted and Section 336 IPC was added later on vide G.D. No. 20 dated 25.06.2021) registered at Sadar Nawanshahr, SBS Nagar and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 26.10.2021, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 14.12.2021 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate

First Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0042 dated 17.05.2021, under Sections 307, 506 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act were deleted and Section 336 IPC was added later on vide G.D. No. 20 dated 25.06.2021) registered at Sadar Nawanshahr, SBS Nagar along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
