The petitioners herein seek the quashing of the FIR bearing No.670 dated 20.09.2021 registered at Police Station Hansi City, Police District Hansi, District Hisar, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Status-report filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State, by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police District Hansi, District Hisar, along-with Annexure R-1, is already available on the file and these documents are taken on the record.

A perusal of the status-report reveals that in Para 8 therein, it

has specifically been deposed that the investigation is still pending and is at its initial stage and in Para 7 therein, it has been mentioned that the further investigation of the case has been handed over to State Crime Branch, Hisar, vide order Annexure R-1.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioners would be moving a fresh petition for claiming the said relief as and when it will become permissible to them under law.

Learned State counsel has no objection to the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
