The instant appeal has been listed today in pursuance of the order dated 21.09.2022 annexed at 'A' herewith and the same has been included in 'Table-E' as prepared by the concerned Branch to categorise the cases wherein the statutory amount has not been deposited.

A perusal of the file reveals that vide order dated 04.12.2012, the application moved by the appellant (owner of the offending vehicle) for dispensing with the deposit of the statutory amount, had been dismissed by this Court. As reflected in 'Table-E', the said statutory amount has not yet been deposited.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant has not contacted him during the *inter-regnum* and rather, the lawyer who represented him before the Court below, has informed that the appellant

has since expired and he has no clue about the legal representatives of the appellant and thus, he has no instructions from the quarter concerned to pursue the present appeal further.

In view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, the appeal in hand stands dismissed for non-deposit of the statutory amount as well as for want of prosecution.
