Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner No.2 Lazar Singh in criminal case having FIR No.145 dated 02.07.2022 registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 IC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

On the last date of hearing, the present petition, qua petitioner No.1-Thomas Singh was dismissed while petitioner No.2 was granted interim bail and directed to join the investigation with the police.

Today counsel for the petitioner no.2 submits that the petitioner No.2- Lazar Singh has joined the investigation with the police, pursuant to the previous order of interim bail passed by this court.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner No.2 and further submits that recovery of the weapon used in commission of crime by the said petitioner is effected and now petitioner No.2 Lazar Singh is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed qua petitioner No.2 and order of interim bail dated 15.09.2022 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
