Present application has been filed with a prayer that the respondents may kindly be directed to comply with order dated 26.11.2021 passed by the respondents themselves.

During the hearing, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioners submits that rather than deciding the present application, the applicant-petitioners will be satisfied in case, the main case is also taken up for hearing and decided in accordance with law keeping in view the grievance which has been raised therein.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of
the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection with regard to the finally deciding the present petition.

Keeping in view the above, on the joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main writ petition is taken up for hearing today itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the grievance of the petitioners in the present writ petition is that certain unauthorized vehicles were operating within the premises of the Bus Stand Hisar which was causing prejudice to the petitioners who are operating their buses keeping in view the route permit granted to them. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the order passed by this Court on 29.10.2021, the respondents called a meeting of all the concerned and respondent No.1 passed an order on 26.11.2021 laying down certain conditions so as to redress the grievance of the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are satisfied with the efforts enumerated in the order dated 26.11.2021 (Annexure A-1) and the only grievance left is that the order should be implemented in true spirit.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that once a order has been passed, the same will be implemented in its true spirit.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having not been pressed any further keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents with liberty to the petitioners that in case they have any grievance with regard to the implementation of the order dated 26.11.2021

(Annexure A-1), they can approach the appropriate authority raising the said

grievance.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any such representation is filed, the same will be dealt with in accordance with law coupled with the order passed by respondent No.1 dated 26.11.2021 (Annexrure A-1) and appropriate order will be passed as expeditiously as possible.

The present petition is disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty, as prayed for.
