Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.112 dated 20.08.2020, under Sections 346, 379, 498 and 34 of IPC (Section 379, 498 and 34 of IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala.

By virtue of the order dated 18.07.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Roop Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more

required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 18.07.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
