[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.07.2019, in CWP No.18128 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.18128 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 27.04.2019 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel states that pursuant to issuance of notice to the respondents in the instant petition, claim made in legal notice dated 27.04.2019, has been rejected and in the circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order dated 14.08.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
