The present Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of direction to the officials respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents and to properly investigate the FIR No. 81 dated 08.06.2017.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the enquiry was conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Amritsar (Rural) and it was recommended that a cancellation report be submitted and on the basis of the said recommendation, the cancellation report has been submitted before the trial Court and present petitioner has filed a private complaint and in view of the same, present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, present petition has become infructuous and the petitioner may be permitted to raise all the pleas which have been made in the present petition before the trial Court.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
